

There are several restaurants within a short walking distance from the building. For those who need their morning cup of coffee, you will find a Tim Horton's and Starbucks nearby. The Starbucks is located in the Loblaws just across the street while the Tim Horton's is located at the corner of Montreal Road and Vanier Parkway.

#### **Dress Code**

Please dress comfortably. We do try our best to provide a comfortable and steady temperature settings in our classrooms. If you tend to get cold, bring your comfy sweater. It might come in handy!

## Parking:

Unfortunately, there is no visitor parking at our building. There is however an abundance of street parking in the neighborhood, typically with a 2 to 3 hours maximum, but to play it safe and try to avoid a parking ticket, have a look at the following three options:

# 283 Cyr Avenue - City of Ottawa public parking

- \$5.50/day (as of June 1, 2021)
- Small lot, only about 25 spots
- Only a 4-minute walk to our building (300 meters)

## 400 North River Road - City of Ottawa public parking

- \$14/day (as of June 1, 2021)
- About 80 parking spots
- A healthy 8-minute walk to our building (650 meters)

## 248 McArthur Avenue - public parking

- \$8/day (as of August 1, 2021)
- About 80 parking spots
- 7-minute walk to our building (600 meters)
